## NOTHING CAN SEPARATE US FROM THE LOVE OF GOD

We will hear this beautiful promise from the Lord in our Epistle reading the last Sunday in July. It comes from Romans 8:38-39. "For I am sure that neither death nor life, nor angels nor rulers, nor things present nor things to come, nor powers, nor height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord." The message is plain and emphatic: Nothing can ever separate us from the love of God!

This promise, however often seems contrary to our actual life experience. When we are beset by grief, depression, poverty, loneliness, unjust criticism, slander, illness, disability, or any other of the numerous troubles that can come our way, it is easy for us to feel like we have been cut off from God's love.

Even so, God still assures us that this is not the case! He still loves us. He still remembers us. He still knows all our pains and sorrows and needs. He still has compassion for us. He still desires to strengthen us and see us through the tough times. He still intends to cause all our troubles to work out somehow for our blessing. Remember that other precious promise from verse 28. "We know that, for those who love God, He works all things together for good."

God simply has not revealed every single detail of His plan for our earthly pilgrimages. He has not written down for us the precise reasons for every problem He permits. It is our place as God's trusting children to wait for Him to work things out in His good timing and manner, all the while confident that His love for us remains undiminished.

After all, the undeniable proof of God's love is ever before us in the cross of our Lord Jesus. God's love for us is so great that He did not spare His own beloved Son, but gave Him up into death for us all! (8:32) Our loving God did this, not because we deserve it, but just because He loves us – because He wanted to save us from our worst troubles of all: sin, death, and hell. And He did save us! In Christ, God gave us forgiveness, everlasting life, and a place reserved in His heavenly kingdom. What more could He do to demonstrate His un-failing love?

So hang on to God's promise, even when the things going on in your life might appear to contradict it. For nothing – absolutely nothing – is more sure than the word of our faithful God! And He says nothing can separate us from His love!

**HI-LITES OF ST. JOHN'S VOTERS ASSEMBLY  
June 8, 2026**

Ross Gould called the meeting to order. A quorum was present. Pastor Bishop opened with devotions.

The May Parish Report was reviewed. A motion was made by Cheryl Ivey, seconded by Nancy Drockelman. Motion carried.

The May meeting minutes were reviewed. A motion was made by Dodie Shecker, seconded by Cheryl Ivey. Motion carried.

Treasurer's Report – Rod Bollinger reviewed the May Treasurer's Reports. For the month of May expenses exceeded income by \$23,079.66. For the year so far, we are showing a deficit of \$49,240.36. Expenses were on target for what is budgeted. Giving versus expenses is following the same trend that was noted at the end of the year. There were two items on the check register \$5,100 for quarterly insurance and \$6,157 for kitchen drain repair that are out of the ordinary. Check registers exceptional items: Guest Pastor, taxes for east bluff and Ewes, Maquet for plumbing repairs, Buzard for pipe organ maintenance, Brotherhood Mutual for property insurance. Motion was made by Nancy Drockelman, seconded by Diane Gould to approve May's Treasurer's Report. Motion carried.

Board of Trustees – Dave Kesselmayer reported that the utilities have been marked for the sewer backflow valve installation. The date for this work has not been set yet. In June the Trustees are finalizing the resume for Sandy's position and will be advertising in the bulletin for a new church secretary. Sandy Ferguson is retiring at the end of the year. The Trustees are opening the position to members first. Ideally, a replacement can be hired so they can shadow Sandy for several months. Comcast lease has been renewed for 3 years. 2026 rent is \$11,453.63 and will increase to \$12,891.16 by 2030. A motion was made by Dave Kesselmayer, seconded by Dave Drockelman to take funds for sewer from building fund. Motion carried.

Board of Elders – Dave Drockelman no report.

Board of Finance – Rod Bollinger reported .

Board of Christian Education – Laura Dobbelaire no report.

John Neuman reported for Good Shepherd School. The board meeting will take place tomorrow night. The board has a budget that will keep expenses the same this year as last for all 3 churches. Approximately 300 people attended the combined church service and following meal at the school to celebrate the retirement of the school building debt. Suggestion was made that we do this 1-2 times per year.

Board of Worship – Diane Gould no report.

Board of Evangelism – Jennifer Kesselmayer reported that the committee is still working on ways to do outreach within the community.

Board of Stewardship – No report.

Long Range Planning Committee – No report.

Educational Grant Fund Committee – No report.

East Bluff Property Committee – Dave Kesselmayer indicated that Gary Pool and Brock Benson have done a lot of work to clean up the property.

Constitution By-laws Committee – No report.

Unfinished business – None.

New business – Gary Pool thanked Brock Benson and Steve Kesselmayer for their help at the cemetery. Ross Gould indicated that the Elders are continuing to look at ways to perform mission events. The district Pastors meeting in October will be hosted at St. John's. We are working on ways to accommodate their meal needs. New stage curtain has been ordered. The stage floor will be refinished. Dave Kesselmayer has been repainting the stage walls.

Ewe's Treasures has donated \$1.9 million to GSLS over 40 years that they have existed. Ewe's is always in need of volunteers; they are very flexible as to when you can assist. Contact Penny Bollinger if you wish to help.

We had a first-time attendee at this meeting. Welcome to Victoria Hill.

A motion was made by Bob Oliverius, seconded by Diane Gould to close the meeting. Motion carried.

The meeting closed with the Lord's Prayer.
